Fly Tying

FLIES THAT KEEP ON GIVING Jurassic Rubber Legs

HOOK: Mustad R90, size 6 (4x strong hook)

THREAD: Uni 8/0 or UTC 70, Black

TAIL: Krystal Flash, Pearl Fine Black wire

BODY: Chenille, Standard size, Black

LEGS: Super Floss, Pearl

GLUE: Gel Super Glue (more working time)

HEAD CEMENT: Super Glue

NOTES:

For Jurassic Lake the 4x heavy wire hook is deemed enough weight.

For use elsewhere, make these changes: HOOK: Daiichi 1550, size 6 BEAD HEAD: 7/64" Black Bead

Tying Instructions:

Tight Lines, John

- 1. Mount the hook in the vise. Tie in the thread behind the headspace. Wrap back to the barb. Spiral wrap the thread forward to the headspace.
- 2. Use four pieces of tail material about 2" long. Fold around the tying thread and bring the material to the top of the hook. Tie in over the hook shank to the back. Trim the tail to match body length.
- 3. Cut a piece of ribbing about 3" long. Lay over the shank with the excess to the back. Wrap the tying thread forward to the headspace, securing the ribbing for use later.
- 4. Spread a light coat of GEL super glue over the top of the materials already installed.
- 5. Tie in the body material over the shank with the excess to the rear.
- 6. Tie in three pieces of wing material perpendicular to the body. One piece about two head spaces from the front, the other two farther back on the shank. The distance between the legs should be about the same as the diameter of the body material. Return the thread to the front.
- 7. Spread light coats of GEL super glue on both the top and bottom of the shank.
- 8. Wrap the body material forward to the front, going between the legs. Tie off behind the eye. Trim excess.
- 9. Counter wrap the ribbing forward. Tie off. Trim excess ribbing.
- 10. Tie a tapered head. Trim tying thread.
- 11. Use super glue to finish the head.
